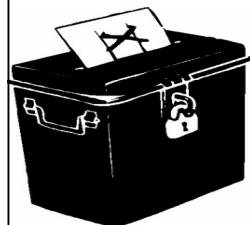

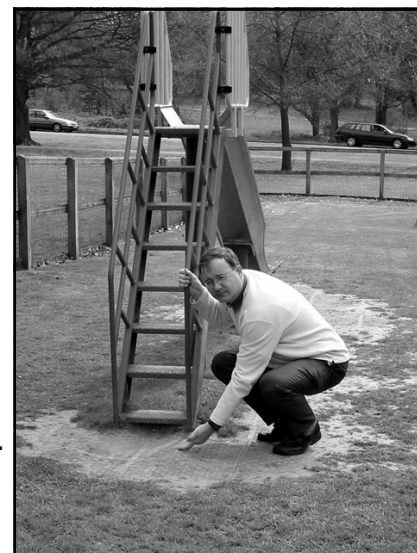

20mph for all schools
